

# Talking can help

HYP-D Services works in Hume with young people and their families on alcohol and other drug (AOD) issues.

The HYP-D worker provides non-judgmental 1:1 counselling and info sessions to young people (aged 12-25) who live in the Hume region and are experiencing problems related to their AOD use or want accurate info on drugs.

This is done in a respectful way, working with the young person to help them achieve their goals, whether this is ceasing or reducing their use or minimising the harms associated with substance use.

ReGen recognises that families can play a critical role in reducing the harms young people experience from AOD use and that they sometimes need support themselves as AOD use can impact negatively on their own health and welfare. The HYP-D worker is available to support family members in this situation.

The HYP-D worker is also available to deliver programs and AOD info sessions in schools and other settings in Hume to raise awareness of the possible impacts of AOD use, treatment options available and to increase the capacity of the community to identify and respond to AOD issues.

### Services we offer

- 1:1 counselling sessions that focus on what the young person wants to achieve (eg. cut down, stop completely, learn more about a drug)
- One off sessions to answer any questions a young person has or to explore their use to see if they might like to do counselling
- Family/carer support
  - Single Sessions (one or two 1.5hr sessions focussing on specific issues) or ongoing counselling to family members/carers who want support and advice about a young person's substance use
- Delivery of AOD information sessions within schools or other settings in Hume

### Where is the Hume region?

Hume is a large council area in the North of Melbourne that includes such suburbs as Broadmeadows, Tullamarine, Diggers Rest, Sunbury, Craigieburn and Roxburgh Park.

### Who can make referrals?

- young people or their families/carers
- support workers
- local schools
- community-based agencies
- health services
